IN RE: ORDER AMENDING LOCAL RULE 72.1(C):
UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGES :

Pursuant to the rule-making authority granted the court by 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Local Rule 72.1(C) is hereby amended to comport with the language of F.R.Civ.P.72(a), by ~~striking~~ and inserting as follows:

An appeal from an order of a magistrate judge determining a pretrial matter shall be filed with the Clerk of Court within ten days ~~from entry of the order~~ after being served with a copy of the order.

The Clerk of Court shall cause notice of this amendment to be published for a period of thirty days, and thereafter furnish a copy of Amended Local Rule 72.1 to the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit and to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
