ORDER AMENDING LOCAL RULE 83.1
TO INSERT A PROVISION GOVERNING
TO COURTROOM ATTIRE

Pursuant to the rule-making authority granted the court by 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Local Rule 83.1 is hereby amended by replacing paragraph (f) with the following provision on courtroom attire:


(f) Courtroom Attire. All attorneys appearing in this court shall be appropriately attired, coat and tie for men, comparable attire for women, and shall not be groomed or attired in a manner reasonably calculated to distract attention from the proceedings, call attention to themselves, or as to show disrespect to the court.

It is further

ORDERED that this local rule's existing paragraphs (f) and (g) be re-designated (g) and (h).
