At its meeting of February 17, 2005, this court adopted a modification to its "Amended Plan for the Random Selection of Grand and Petit Jurors" (Jury Plan), as approved by the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit of the United States effective April 29, 1993, to increase the minimum number of names in the master wheels for both the Memphis and Jackson divisions. The increase is prompted by requirements of an increase in jury trials. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that Section V, "Master Jury Wheels," of the Jury Plan be amended to read that at the refilling of the master wheels every four years following each general election, the minimum number of names to be placed in the master wheel of the Western Division be increased from 60,000 to 75,000, and the number of names in the Eastern Division wheel be increased from 15,000 to 25,000.


The revised Amended Jury Plan shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by this court, and shall remain so until such time as the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit may direct otherwise. Nothing in this modification shall preclude the service of any juror summoned or empaneled on or before the date upon which this modification shall become effective.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court notify the Sixth Circuit Judicial Council, the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, and the Attorney General of the United States of the modification herein described, consistent with provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 1863(a).
