
ORDER APPROVING OCCUPANT EMERGENCY PLAN

The U.S. General Services Administration is the agency responsible for insuring the safety and security of people while they are on federal property. The Federal Management Regulations specifically require the General Services Administration to assist federal agencies that occupy federal facilities in establishing and maintaining an occupancy emergency program. An occupancy emergency program is a short-term emergency response program that establishes procedures for safeguarding lives and property during emergencies in federal facilities.


On July 14, 2004, a building security committee was appointed to establish an occupancy emergency plan for the United States Courthouse for the Western District of Tennessee, Eastern Division. The committee has now completed their task and has developed an "Occupant Emergency Plan" for the United States Courthouse located at 111 S. Highland Avenue in Jackson, Tennessee.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the "Occupant Emergency Plan" attached to this order is hereby **APPROVED**. The plan shall go into effect May 1, 2005, and will remain in effect until such time as an order revising, vacating or replacing the plan is entered.


