Pham to be an active work-in-progress or assigned to Judge Vescovo or Judge Pham by consent of the parties, be reassigned to Magistrate Judge Edward Bryant.


It is further

ORDERED that all Jackson cases and matters referable to a magistrate judge be referred/assigned to Magistrate Judge Edward Bryant effective December 15, 2008.

It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk randomly infuse the Memphis case assignment box with Judge Bryant's name in sufficient number as to render an equitable distribution of case assignments among the magistrate judges of this district, and that the Clerk enter this order upon the records of the court.
