

The Merit Selection Panel shall review each incumbent's current service as magistrate judge, the comments from members of the bar and public, and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, legal ability, temperament and commitment to equal justice under the law. The panel shall report to the court, within ninety day after the date of this order, its recommendation as to whether Magistrate Judge Diane K. Vescovo and Magistrate Judge Tu M. Pham should be reappointed to an additional term of office.

The Clerk of Court is directed to cause to be published public notices regarding the reappointment of Magistrate Judge Diane K. Vescovo and Magistrate Judge Tu M. Pham . The notices shall be published as specified in the *Guide to Judiciary Polices* and shall be filed and posted in the office of the Clerk of Court and provided to the Director of the Administrative Office.
