ORDER

Pursuant to the Judicial Conference Committee on Court Administration and Case Management Guidelines for the cameras pilot project in the district courts, local rule 83.2(a) is hereby revised to include a limited exception to the ban on recording and publication of district court proceedings. The exception to local rule 83.2 (a) becomes effective Monday, July 18, 2011 and will read as follows:

EXCEPTION: There is a limited exception to the ban on recording and publication of district court proceedings as set forth in this rule for district judges participating in a pilot program established by the Judicial Conference of the United States in September 2010 (JCUS-SEP 10, pp.3-4) to evaluated the effect of cameras in district court courtrooms, of video recordings of proceedings therein, and of publication of such video recordings.

Any recording and publication conducted pursuant to the pilot program must comply with the program guidelines issued by the Judicial Conference Committee on Court Administration and Case Management, pursuant to the pilot program (available at www.uscourts.gov).

The Clerk of Court shall cause notice of the revision to be published on the court's web page for a period of twenty-one (21) days, and thereafter furnish a copy of the Revised Local Rules to the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit.
