Administrative Order No. 2023-15

In compliance with the determination of the District Judges of the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee and in the interests of the court and the public, a Court Pro Se Committee is hereby established. The purpose of the Committee is to develop a strategy to implement necessary changes that will improve the overall quality, efficiency, and effectiveness of the Pro Se Law Clerk Program while monitoring the work product of the program and addressing any issues that may arise.

The committee will consist of a United States District Judge; a United States Magistrate Judge; the Clerk of Court; a representative from the Pro Se Law Clerk unit; and two Chambers Law Clerks. The committee will report all findings and recommendations to the United States District Judges of the Western District of Tennessee.
