The Judicial Conference of the United States, through its Executive Committee, has notified the United States District Courts that, due to a severe shortage in the Fiscal Year 1993 Fees of Jurors appropriation, the last day on which funds will be available to pay civil jurors is Friday, June 18, 1993

Having been forewarned of and in anticipation of this event, the judges of this court agreed at their April 27 meeting to suspend the empanelment of civil juries until the Congress of the United States has made available to the Federal Judiciary sufficient funds to permit the lifting of this restriction. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that only civil juries which have been empaneled for the trial of a specific case, and juries which have already commenced hearing testimony or conducting deliberations prior to June 18, 1993 may continue to serve until those cases are concluded.
