IN RE: ORDER PROHIBITING CAMERAS ON
COURT FLOORS

It is the opinion of the judges of this district that the interests of justice and security are best served by alleviating the congestion and commotion attendant to television cameras and crews who congregate in the public corridors outside of the district's courtrooms. It is therefore

ORDERED, that cameras shall not be permitted on any of the court floors above the second floor of the Clifford Davis Federal Building in Memphis and the main floor of the Ed Jones Federal Building and Courthouse in Jackson, Tennessee. Exception to this prohibition can be obtained for special proceedings in response to written requests timely submitted to the judge presiding at the proceeding.
