IN RE: ISSUANCE OF SERVICE IN NON-
PRISONER PAID *PRO SE* COMPLAINTS

Consistent with the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals' opinion in *McGore v. Wrigglesworth*, 114 F.3d 601 (6th Cir. 1997), and its Administrative Order No. 97-01, it is

ORDERED that service not be issued upon the filing of a non-prisoner *pro se* complaint when a filing fee is paid, pending review of the complaint's merit under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2). Section 1915 (e)(2) provides that whether or not a filing fee is paid, the court shall dismiss a case at any time upon the court's determination that any of the § 1915(e)(2) provisions are met.

It is further,

ORDERED that upon the filing of a non-prisoner *pro se* complaint when the filing fee is paid, the Clerk's Office will promptly direct a copy of the complaint to the *Pro Se* Staff Attorneys' Office for priority screening, and will refrain from issuing summons to the plaintiff for service on the defendant(s) until instructed to do so by court order.
