This court's Administrative Order Number 98-17 provides for the establishment of the "Plan for the Appointment of Counsel for Pro Se Indigent Parties in Civil Cases of the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee," (the Plan) with the corresponding creation of the "Pro Bono Expense Fund" to be funded from proceeds deposited in the Court Improvement Fund. The method by which the Pro Bono Expense Fund is to be financed is articulated in the Plan, and reflected in Local Rules 83.1 and 83.2, with changes to both being enabled by Administrative Order 98-19.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that effective August 1, 1998, the attorney admissions fee increase from \$60 to \$100, and the Pro Hac Vice admissions fee increase from \$10 to \$100.

It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court commence collection of a \$10 annual "Good Standing" enrollment fee in January 1999, upon mailing notice to all members enrolled in the Bar of this court.
