## Annie T. Christoff Sworn in as United States Magistrate Judge

The United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee is pleased to announce that Annie T. Christoff took the Oath of Office in a private ceremony July 24, 2020, to serve as a magistrate judge for the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. A date for the public investiture ceremony has not yet been set.

Magistrate Judge Christoff was appointed by the District Court to fill the position left vacant by Magistrate Judge Diane K. Vescovo, who retired in May.

Magistrate Judge Christoff received her law degree from Georgetown University Law Center in 2007 and her Bachelor of Arts degree from Tulane University in 2000. Magistrate Judge Christoff was an Assistant United States Attorney in the Western District of Tennessee, and prior to that was a litigation partner at Bass, Berry & Sims, PLC. Magistrate Judge Christoff served as law clerk to U.S. District Judge Jon P. McCalla from 2007-2008.
